<p>Pre-Camp</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ask Camper/Staff to arrive healthy - health assessment given out to all campers (14 day assessment before camp) 2. Collect and Review Health History with Record of Immunizations 3. Describe Health Screening Process for staff and families before arrival 4. Evaluate/order supply of protective equipment: gloves, masks, etc... 5. Conduct Health Screenings for both staff and campers that includes screening for communicable disease 6. Identify CDP Team responsible for critical services & conduct training prior to start of camp. (Jim Bryer & Meg Myles) 7. 2 certified Contact Tracers on staff. 8. Define Tipping Point for Launching CDP Interventions 9. Define Isolation capabilities & criteria for sending home 10. Contact appropriate insurance and local EMS personnel 11. <p>Outbreak Occurs</p>	<p>1. Convene meeting of CDP Team.</p> <p>2. Notify RIDOH</p> <p>3. Identify symptoms and illness as soon as possible.</p> <p>4. Identify key health services support needs</p> <p>5. Start Contact Tracing or Provide info to RIDOH</p> <p>6. Communication to campers, staff, CISF Board</p>	<p>Daily Meetings once Outbreak occurs – revisit processes daily.</p> <p>Consult with medical provider & provide ongoing updates during the outbreak.</p> <p>Staffing, isolation arrangements, supplies, prevention of cross-contamination, care for well staff & campers, medication management, documentation.</p> <p>Spokesperson(s) for families, media, public health dept, insurance, unaffected campers/staff, collect/save documentation of communication</p> <p>Access to separate toilet and hand-washing facilities; emptying trash; ventilation/climate control; transportation, laundry service</p>

RECOVERY/MITIGATION	ACTIVITIES	TOOLS/CONSIDERATIONS
Resolution	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Clean & Disinfect Facilities, boats, equipment, motorboats, etc... 2. 24 hour cancellation of camp to clean & disinfect 3. CDP Team Evaluation - make changes to processes where needed 4. Documentation of illness 5. Debrief Camp & facilitate return-to-routine camp practices. 6. Update/revise staff, parent and camper materials to more effectively address CDP. 	<p>Provide critical incident debriefing</p> <p>Review all operational activities to determine effectiveness and identify potentials for change; update policy/procedures.</p> <p>Confirm completion of documentation by all required individuals – health center staff, spokesperson(s), camp director, business manager, insurance carrier.</p> <p>Listen to experiences of all staff and campers who wish to share experience. Allow time for staff rest and recuperation.</p>
